Promise Scholars Program Guidelines

The Promise Foundation International Inc. announces The Promise Foundation Scholars Program. Under the Promise Scholars Program, students will be awarded tuition assistance to attend high schools, colleges and universities within Belize, Jamaica, Trinidad & Tobago, Barbados and Nigeria. The level of education being funded by the award is dependent on the country within which the student resides and is determined at the discretion of the Board of Directors, which is comprised of minority women hailing from a variety of countries.

Available Tuition Assistance:

Belize City, Belize: <u>Two</u> scholarship awards for school fees and books for students accepted to St. Catherine's Academy, Pallotti High School or St. John's College.

Kingston, Jamaica: <u>Five</u> scholarship awards for tuition and books for students in 1st to 4th form attending Meadowbrook High School.

Nigeria: One tuition and books scholarship award for a student of an eligible high school of Nigeria

Trinidad & Tobago: Up to 1 - \$1,000 US tuition award for students enrolled in college or university level STEM programs.

Barbados: Up to 1 - \$1000 US tuition awards for students enrolled in college or university level STEM programs.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking high school school students of Jamaica, Belize & Nigeria and college /university level students of Barbados and Trinidad & Tobago with a record of high academic achievement, volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities, participation in extracurricular school activities and interests in the fields of STEM and education.
 - * Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0/Three (3) CAPE subject passes, a total single parent/family annual income under \$20,000/\$40,000 US dollars.
- * Tuition Assistance funds will be paid prior to the start of the semester of the student's academic year directly to the high school or college and not to the student.

* Applicants must have the endorsement of their school representative on their application attesting they are a qualified fit for this program. The Promise Foundation International strongly suggests that each high school present this opportunity to the strongest applicants that match this program's guidelines. Application deadline is June 7th by 4:00 p.m. to be received by the Foundation.



Late applications will not be accepted.




(6) <u>Student Requirements to Maintain Scholarship For the</u> <u>Academic Year</u>
